



# Cleats for Sports Netting

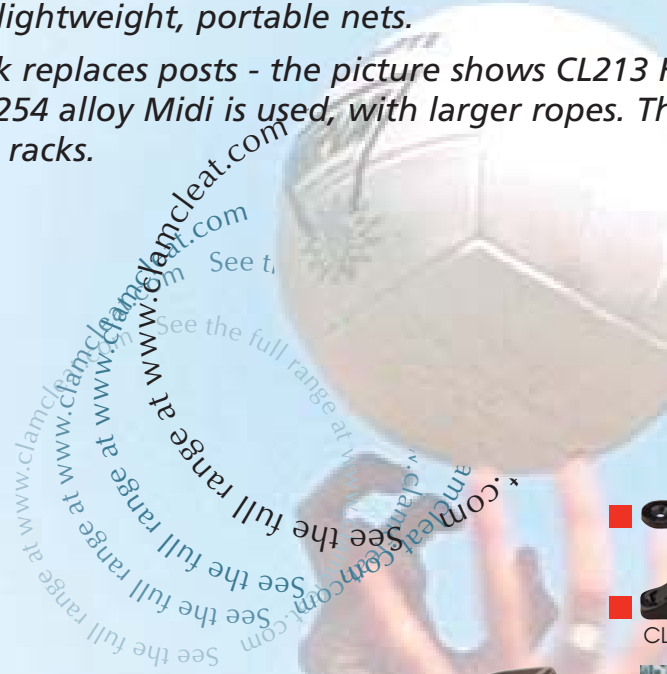
Leading Sports Net manufacturers are using Clamcleat® rope cleats for tensioning nets and headlines.

- In ski resorts, barrier nets are used to keep spectators away from the piste when watching ski racers. Both the CL223 and CL234 are used to tension snow netting.

- The CL211 Mk2 is used as a net tensioner on this beach volleyball set.

- The CL223 is ideal for tensioning both volley ball and badminton nets. Use the CL260 for tensioning lightweight, portable nets.

Where a wall rack replaces posts - the picture shows CL213 Fine Line cleats, but for heavier duty nets, the CL254 alloy Midi is used, with larger ropes. The CL204 and CL217 Mk1 are also used on wall racks.



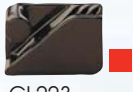
These four cleats are used to tension nets on wall racks.



Cleats used to tension snow netting



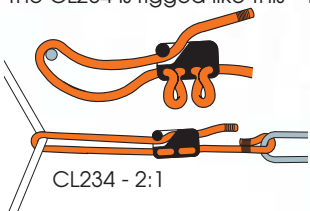

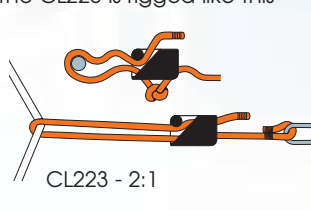

## Rope size and Cleats

1/16" - 3/16" (2-5mm) Ø	CL260	Green square
1/8" - 1/4" (3-6mm) Ø	CL204, CL211 Mk2, CL213, CL217 Mk1, CL223	Red square
3/16" - 5/16" (4-8mm) Ø	CL254	Blue square
1/4" - 1/2" (6-12mm) Ø	CL234	Yellow square
